On the Morning of Saturday 18 January 2025, we will host our Coolabah Turf Junior Triathlon & Duathlon, with the event scheduled to start at 9:00am. The event starts and finishes at Moama Beach. As a result, there will be an increase in the number of people in and around Moama Beach and access roads including Blair Street and Bartlett Street which are subject to temporary road closures. ### The following roads will be subject to a temporary road closure on SATURDAY 18 JANUARY from 8:30am-10:00am

- Blair Street, Moama from Bartlett Street through to Moama Beach
- Bartlett Street, Moama, from Blair Street through to Dhungala Bridge
- Echuca-Moama Bridge underpass to Moama Beach

*Traffic management personnel will be directing vehicular movement in the impacted areas. Access to Moama Soundshell and its parking will not be impacted. All roads will be re-opened at 10:00am or at the earliest opportunity prior. Please take our event into consideration with your planned movements in the area to minimise any inconvenience.*

### Other road closures on SATURDAY 18 JANUARY 5:15pm to 7:30pm:

- Dickson Street, Echuca
- High Street from Warren Street to Radcliffe Street, Echuca
- Leslie Street from High Street to Murray Esplanade, Echuca
- Murray Esplanade from Hopwood Place to Radcliffe Street, Echuca
- Hare Street from Radcliffe Street to Heygarth Street, Echuca
- Heygarth Street from Hare Street to Echuca-Moama Bridge, Echuca-Moama
- Echuca-Moama Bridge from Heygarth Street to Meninya Street, Echuca/Moama
- Meninya Street to Blair Street, Moama

*With the Echuca-Moama Bridge closed in both directions during these times, the only passage between Echuca and Moama will be via the Dhungala Bridge. Please find a copy of the event course on the reverse side of this notice.*

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Traffic management personnel will be directing vehicular movement in the impacted areas. Event marshals will also assist pedestrians in high traffic areas. Please take our event into consideration with your planned movements in the area, to minimise any inconvenience.

Sunday 19 January 2025: There will be a rolling river closure of the Murray River from Echuca-Moama Bridge to Morrisons Riverview Winery, Moama between 9:15am and 11:00am, for the Cavalier Homes Wharf to Winery Swim.

During these time no vessels will be able to enter or make their way up / down the waterway.
